**3. God changes us through the

**Fact: God's number one purpose in your life is not to make you happy – it is to make you holy – just as Christ was holy.**

1. I can choose what I THINK about.

“Finally, brothers and sisters,  
whatever is true, whatever is noble, whatever  
is right, whatever is pure, whatever is lovely,  
whatever is admirable—if anything is excellent  
or praiseworthy—think about **such things.**”

Philippians 4:8 (NIV)



## II. My Part in Changing Me

1. I can choose what I THINK about.

Do not conform to the pattern of this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind. Then you will be able to test and approve what God's will is—his good, pleasing and perfect will. Romans 12:2 (NIV)



## II. My Part in Changing Me

2. I can choose to DEPEND on God.

“Remain in me, as I also remain in you. No branch can bear fruit by itself; it must remain in the vine. Neither can you bear fruit unless you remain in me.”

“I am the vine; you are the branches. If you remain in me and I in you, you will bear much fruit; apart from me you can do nothing.”

John 15:4-5 (NIV)
